



Quick Start Guide to the Somerset Health & Wellbeing Framework Audit Tool

Gain **access** to the Somerset Health & Wellbeing Framework Audit Tool, you will need to request a log in.

This is personal to your school. As a school you hold responsibility for sharing this with others within your school site or external support such as MHST, school governors etc

Explore the Audit tool principles and statements recognising existing good practice and using the RAG system.

The **RAG** rating should be completed as follows -

Red = Not working on this and **no** evidence towards this statement.

Amber = Started working to this statement and have some or **developing** evidence

Green = Actively embedding this statement in practice and have **completed** and **uploaded evidence** to demonstrate this

Contact your Education Mental Health Practitioner (EMHP) for MHST sites and share who the SMHL is, that is implementing the SHWF.

Communicate the aims of a Whole School Approach and the process for developing this through the SHWF to your whole school community.

Include the SHWF as a standing item at **SLT meetings**.

Raise awareness of the whole school approach to health & wellbeing to the whole school community (pupils, staff, families, governors, others).

Invite colleagues to support developing Wellbeing Action Group (WAG) process.

Include the SHWF as a standing item at **staff meetings**.
